What to expect and what is expected of you to help minimise the risk of spreading COVID 19 whilst playing cricket at Rockhampton CC.

The cricket club will continue to welcome all players, officials and supporters as we always have done, all we ask is you follow some simple hygiene rules to keep yourself and others safe during the Covid 19 pandemic

The safety of our members, volunteers and guests are most important to us, therefore we have decided to close the pavilion off to all players, officials & supports other than for the use of the toilets.

As a committee our ambition is to get our fantastic facilities open and safe for all to use as soon as possible. Please be rest assured we will be following the Government & ECB guidelines very closely. We expect restrictions to continue to be eased on a regular basis and as such will apply these to our approach each week. We will continue to communicate these changes via our social media pages and Captains prior to games and training

Please follow all signage around the club, keep to the one way systems in the clubhouse, respect the views of others and **keep to social distancing laws** (minimum 1m+)

- Please park in available spaces in the car park or along the hedge line past the nets up to the pond area
Remember to keep to social distancing requirements
- Please sign in at the clubhouse (playing field entrance) on arrival
We will require contact information for NHS track & trace purposes
- The club house will remain closed other than for the use of toilets
Please respect the one-way system clearly marked out & use toilets, one person at a time
- The bar will be open via a takeaway service, ordering from the front doors opening onto the playing field (not the car park entrance!)
Payment by contactless card machine
For the time being we will only be offering cans and bottles with disposable plastic glasses
To minimise the handling of waste we would appreciate it if you could take your waste cans/bottles etc home with you
- Please bring your own chair & do not share with others
To help reduce the risk of spreading the virus + minimise the need of cleaning after every use – antibac wipes are available on request
Please refrain from using clubhouse and boundary edge benches
- Please return to your OWN cars for rain/weather shelter
The club house & groundsman's sheds etc will not be available to keep to social distancing laws
