What to expect and what is expected of you to help minimise the risk of spreading COVID 19 whilst playing cricket at Rockhampton CC.

The cricket club will continue to welcome all players, officials and supporters as we always have done, all we ask is you follow some simple hygiene rules to keep yourself and others safe during the Covid 19 pandemic

The safety of our members, volunteers and guests are most important to us, therefore we have decided to close the pavilion off to all players, officials & supports other than for the use of the toilets.

As a committee our ambition is to get our fantastic facilities open and safe for all to use as soon as possible. Please be rest assured we will be following the Government & ECB guidelines very closely. We expect restrictions to continue to be eased on a regular basis and as such will apply these to our approach each week. We will continue to communicate these changes via our social media pages and Captains prior to games and training

Please follow all signage around the club, keep to the one way systems in the clubhouse, respect the views of others and **keep to social distancing laws** (minimum 1m+)

- **Please bring your own food for the tea break (store in a cool bag in your car)**
There will be no kitchen facilities available
- **Please bring enough water for the day (recommend a minimum 2 Litre bottle)**
Tap water available on request - please limit the use of taps and clean after use
- **Please take all your waste home with you!**
To help reduce waste handling by our club volunteers
- **Please bring your own chair & do not share with others**
This is to help reduce the need of cleaning after every use
- **Please wash your hands and use hand gel provided before and after taking the field**
To help reduce the spread whilst handling the Vector (Ball)
- **Do not share any cricket kit!**
To help reduce the spread between players
- **DO NOT use saliva to shine the cricket ball**
- **Please leave jumpers on the boundary edge if removed to bowl**
Umpires will not be expected to hold any items of clothing
- **Please return to your OWN cars for rain/weather shelter –**
The club house & groundsman's sheds etc will not be available to keep to social distancing laws
- **Away team captain – please provide a list of playing team (and supporters if possible) to the home captain**
To help with NHS track and trace records
- For RCC players on away games,
Please travel by yourself or with members from your own household – DO NOT car share
If you are meeting at the Boundary Field or Common please remain by your vehicles in the car park
